Brief Summary of Position Purpose:

- Contribute to creation of product literature and create training and support material for sales reps and distributors.
- Support product manager in product roadmap process, voice of customer input, tracking industry and standards, and preparing technical bulletins, product announcements, and application notes.
- Respond to product inquiries from internal and external audiences.
- Represent company and products at trade shows.
- Other duties as directed by the Product Manager.
